

Confirmation Banners

Keeping with St. John Church tradition, the confirmandis will be making banners to hang in church for the weeks surrounding Confirmation. Your student will be picking out a Confirmation color of felt for his or her banner. A bag with the felt and a dowel rod for hanging will be sent home in the following weeks. Below are the guidelines. The designs of the banner are up to you and your student, but please follow the guidelines so that all the banners coordinate.

1. The confirmandi's full name, including the saint, is to be the main part of the banner. Felt letters with adhesive on the back are frequently used to create the name.
2. Place any other appropriate decorations on the banner. Ideas include a cross, dove, tongues of fire, Bible, symbols representing the saint, etc. This is where the confirmandi's creativity will shine.
3. Attach the top of the banner to the dowel rod. The banners must be designed and hung horizontally.
4. Tie decorative string, ribbon or rope to each end of the dowel rod.
5. The banner may be edged with ribbon or lace.
